ASHP House of Delegates Votes on Fifteen Policy Recommendations

The ASHP House of Delegates held a virtual voting meeting between March 14-21, 2025 on 15 policy recommendations from various

committees and councils within the organization. Ultimately seven policy recommendations met the 85% or more approval threshold to pass through the House of Delegates. Five of these seven approved recommendations were for discontinuation of previous policies, while two were recommendations for new policies. The new policies addressed include Professional Development as a Retention Tool and Pharmacy Access to Payer Networks.
