Patient Access to Pharmacists' Services - Congress Reintroduces Legislation

Congress reintroduced bipartisan legislation, the [Ensuring Community Access to Pharmacist Services \(ECAPS\) Act](#) (H.R. 3164) to ensure access to pharmacists' services for

seniors under Medicare Part B. This would allow pharmacist reimbursement as providers for vaccination, testing, and treatment of common respiratory infections. KSHP together with ASHP and 48 hospitals, health systems, and pharmacy organizations recently [asked Congress to pass ECAPS](#).
