Kentucky Board of Pharmacy Regulatory Update

Please take note that beginning January 1, 2026, the Kentucky Board of Pharmacy will begin enforcing the 2022 revisions of USP 795 and 797. Additionally, portions of USP 800 specifically as they apply to non-sterile and sterile compounding will be enforced as well. 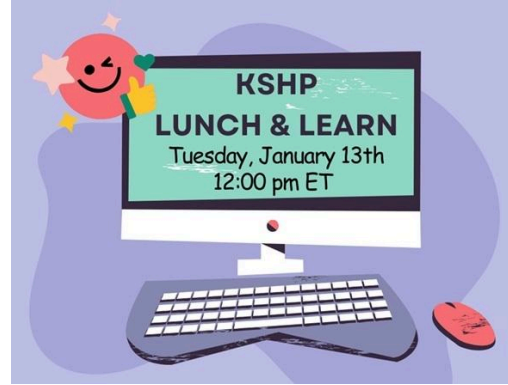
