The Kentucky Board of Pharmacy (KYBOP) has posted a number of rule revisions. All rule revisions were filed December 12, 2025 and are scheduled for a public hearing date on

February 27, 2026 (at 9AM via Zoom) and a public comment date (via written submission) by February 28, 2026.
