Advocacy Alert: House Bill 3 Passes Senate and Signed by the Governor



Kentucky House Bill 3 – An Act relating to reimbursement for pharmacist services has passed through both the Senate and the House and was signed by the Governor on 4/13/26. We thank Representative Amy Neighbors and Senator Craig Richardson for their unwavering support in pushing forward both House Bill 3 and Senate Bill 38 in support of pharmacists and pharmacy services in the state of Kentucky. HB3 will take effect 90 days after the adjournment of the General Assembly session on April 15th.
